Dear Lake Herman Property Owner:

The Lake Herman Sanitary District exists to ensure that wastewater treatment systems around Lake Herman are properly installed and maintained. As Lake Herman relies on individual onsite wastewater treatment systems (septic tanks and holding tanks) rather than on a centralized sewer system, each property owner has a responsibility to take care of his or her own system.

To help you fulfill that responsibility, the District has prepared the enclosed flier, "Septic Tank Operation and Maintenance: A Homeowner's Guide." If you have developed property in the Lake Herman Sanitary District, we hope you will find the information included in this flier helpful in understanding how your septic system works. The tips included should also help you keep your septic system working for a good long time.

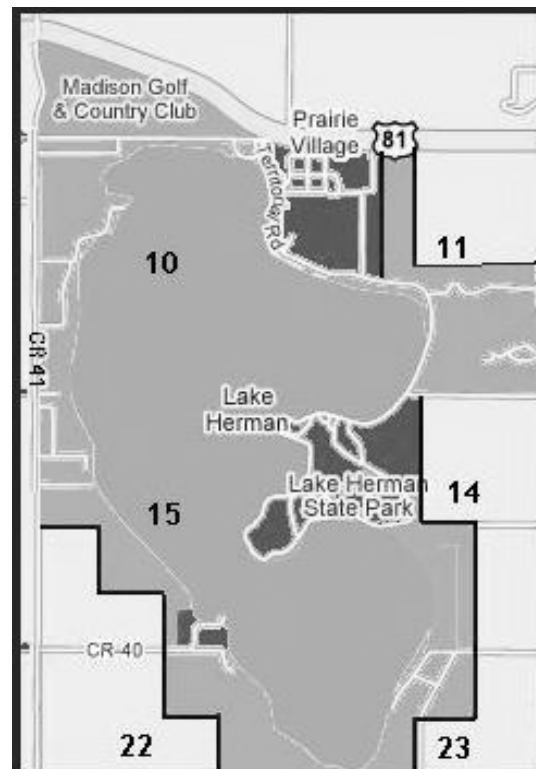
